## Elections & Boundaries Department checking Oceana's referendum sigatures

With municipal elections set for March and Prime Minister Dean Barrow's announcement that he will call General Elections this year, the pace of work has picked up noticeably for the staff of the Elections and Boundaries Department, who are even working over the weekends.

But the weekend grind of the Elections and Boundaries Department staff also has to do with the referendum process triggered by the non-government organization, Oceana.

Chief Elections Officer Josephine Tamai told *The Reporter* her officers are hard at work verifying the ten percent signatures that Oceana collected and which the Governor General's office passed to her department.

The department, she explained, has to go through each and every signature submitted on December 9. They have up to February 9 to complete the exercise.

Once that has been accomplished, the department will then send the results back to the Governor General, who, by the law, has one month to decide if he will issue the Writ of Referendum.

She also said her department had not received the earlier petition sent to the Governor General by Friends of Belize to trigger a referendum on the 9th Amendment.
